

PRESENTATIONS

Example: Grahmann, E. D., F. S. Smith, M. W. Hehman, T. E. Fulbright, B. A. Martin, D. B. Wester, and F. Hernández. 2018. Restoration of native plants in areas dominated by buffelgrass and Old World bluestems. 50th annual Meeting of The Texas Chapter of The Wildlife Society, Austin, Texas. (Presentation)

4. Provide a list of laymen presentations given during the current year to general audiences at state, regional, and national-international venues. Report in the following format and in order. Examples of laymen presentations include presentations to birding clubs, King Ranch Symposium, South Texas Wildlife Conference, Javelina Research Symposium, Pathways, etc.

Example: Grahmann, E. and F. Hernández. June 2018. Use of radiotelemetry to monitor quail survival and movements. The Bobwhite Brigade. Texas AgriLife Extension Service. Pearsall, Texas.

PUBLICATIONS

5. Provide a list of scientific peer-reviewed publications appearing in print during the current year in state, regional, and-or national-international scientific journals. Report in the following format and in order.

Example: Williford, D., R. W. DeYoung, R. L. Honeycutt, L. A. Brennan, F. Hernández, J. R. Heffelfinger, and L. A. Harveson. 2018. Phylogeography of the Gambel's Quail (*Callipepla gambelii*) complex of western North America. Wilson Journal of Ornithology 126: 218–235.

6. Provide a list of popular publications appearing in print during the current year in newspapers, newsletters, magazines, etc. Report in the following format.

Example: Grahmann, E. D., F. Hernández, and L. A. Brennan. 2018. Quail nesting ecology in South Texas. Texas Wildlife Magazine. October Issue.

Examples:

Volunteer. January 2021. South Texas Charity Weekend. Caesar Kleberg Wildlife Research Institute, Kingsville, Texas.
